Education - Helping Youth Achieve Academically

A child living in poverty who cannot read at grade level by the end of 3rd grade is more likely to fall behind, become frustrated with school, and drop out in high school. To support children and boost student achievement, we currently fund 24 educational programs focused on strategies proven to achieve long-term student success. We prepare children for school and support youth for school success, community engagement, and high school graduation.

Health - Healthy Adults and Healthy Children

To improve the health of people living in York County, United Way financially supports 28 programs. We help young mothers and babies get off to a good start, engage youth and older adults in staying active and eating healthy, provide counseling services, and shelter and support services for victims of violence.

Financial Stability - Meeting Basic and Crisis Needs

Moving people permanently out of poverty requires complex solutions. We currently fund 15 programs that provide for basic and emergency needs of families while they are learning new skills, enrolling in assistance programs, finding child care or securing a safe place to live.
